Swachta Pakhwada (September 1 – 15)



From 1st September 2023, School observed Swachhta Pakhwada. In the morning assembly, pledge on Swachhta was administered to the students and the staff members. There was cleaning of premises on 03.09.2023 for which teachers and students participated. Removal of unwanted things from the Teachers' room, computer room, examination department and all other classes was carried out by the students and teachers.



Tree plantation was carried out in front of the School block to remove unwanted weedings and blocks. To promote the idea of Swachhta, the School walls were decorated by the students. They painted the wall under the supervision of our Art teacher. Essay writing competition was conducted for teachers on teacher's day i.e. on 05.09.2023 and the topic was 'Cleanliness and Hygiene'. The same topic was given for students for the essay writing and the competition was held on 07.09.2023. Hindi Pakhwada (September 1 - 14)



Hindi Diwas is celebrated on September 14 every year to commemorate the adoption of Hindi as the official language of India by the Constituent Assembly of India on this day in 1949. Pandit Jawaharlal Nehru, the first prime minister of India, officially declared 14 September as the Hindi Diwas.



This day is observed to promote and celebrate linguistic diversity of India, with a focus on the Hindi language's importance and significance. On this day, academic institutions held programmes and teachers and students gave a speech on the importance of Hindi.
